

DES PTA 2018 Read-A-Thon GUIDE

It's time for Darnestown Elementary School PTA's largest fundraiser, the DES PTA READ-A-THON!!!! The Read-A-Thon provides almost ALL of our annual PTA funding for school social events, media center books and technology, additional classroom supplies, science education, and cultural enrichment programs; and school enhancements like the playground shade pavilion, courtyard benches & tables, hands-on mosaic artwork, and individual student headphones. Our Fundraising Goal is \$13,000.

The READ-A-THON is easy and fun! Everyone can participate! Students determine a daily goal of minutes they will spend reading. Based on the grade level and amount of minutes read, students earn daily reading medals. (See the Medal Tracker in this packet). Students ask family and friends for pledges. Pledges can by based on the amount of medals earned, a flat donation, or a combination.

Students track their minutes and medals earned during the READ-A-THON. Students also track pledges from family and friends. See the attached worksheets for minute/medal tracking and pledge tracking. At the end of the tracking period, medals are tallied and pledges are collected. Parents should verify student totals.


There are two GRAND PRIZE categories!

- 1. The students who raise the most dollars win Fundraising Grand Prizes. This is determined schoolwide.
- 2. Each classroom has a Reading Grand Prize. Every time a student earns a medal, their name is entered into a random drawing for their Classroom Grand Prize. The Classroom Grand Prize will be an exclusive event with their teacher.
 - a. Gold medals are equal to 3 entries;
 - b. Silver medals are 2 entries;
 - c. Bronze medals are 1 entry.

To be eligible for READING PRIZES, students must record their medal count using the DES PTA READ-A-THON app found on the PTA Website, **darnestownelementary.my-pta.org** by **8pm on Friday, October 19**th.

To be eligible for FUNDRAISING PRIZES, students must turn in pledge dollars to school by 4pm or online by 8pm on Friday, October 19th.


